JUDGING CRITERIA

Content: Is the content educational? No obscene or indecent content. Content must be up to date, relevant and engaging.

Over all experience: How is the site organized in terms of content, structure and navigation and visual design and how functional is it? The overall experience of a site visitor to a web site is important.

Visual Design: The appearance of the game and the use of graphics/animation. The site must have good graphics/animation and be user friendly for students.

Terms and condition: It is assumed that the entire content of the game submitted are original and the entrants to the competition have the right, and where applicable the permission to use the tools and content they used in putting the game together. The organizer/s of this competition is not liable for any copyright infringements on the part of the entrant/s.
