

# Hawaii STEM Conference 2012 - Video Competition

Student-created videos are a perfect way to showcase creativity and display your experiences in the classroom. The theme this year is STEM and Service Learning in Hawaii.

**General Concept** — Promoting “STEM (Science, Tech, Engineering, and Math) and Service-Learning in Hawaii” theme by highlighting some of the key components of the two concepts -- *community involvement, technology integration, critical thinking, innovation, problem solving, self-directed learning, teamwork, and service*. How do you, as a young person involved in a STEM/Service-Learning program, see the two areas making a difference in your life and in Hawaii. Why should students, parents, decision makers, teachers, administrators, and the general community care about STEM and Service Learning? Highlight some key pieces of excellence taking place with you, or in your classroom.

## Video Competition Guidelines

Videos should be original and completely student-created. No copyrighted material allowed without permission. Entries may not contain: inappropriate, violent, or risky behavior. Contestants give MEDB’s Women In Technology the right to publish the video in part or whole in any medium without compensation.

**Size/Orientation:** Video screen size should be at least 640X480.

**File Format:** All submissions must be in .avi or .mov format.
